What do I eat ?

Insects, beetles, crickets, worms and snails in the leaf litter and rotting wood.

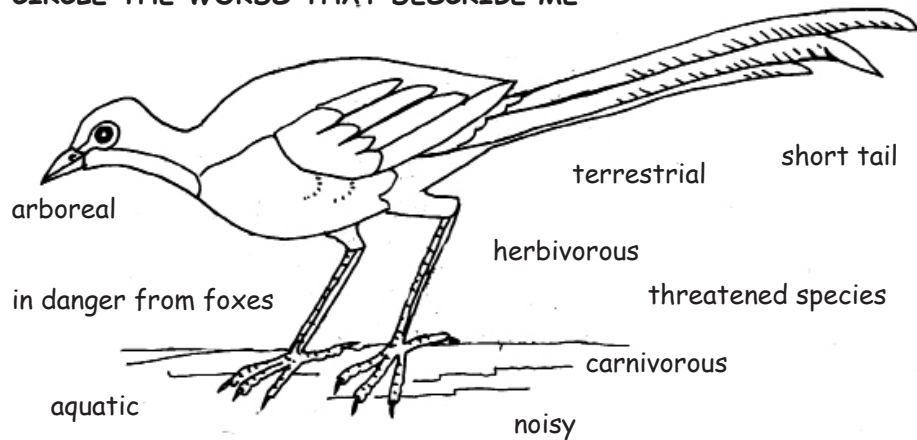
Things I do !
